The County Clerk's office is located at 201 W Main St, Suite 202, Huntsville, AR 72740. An objection must be filed with the County Clerk in writing prior to the following deadlines. An objection that an official is a spouse of a county election commissioner, a county party chair, or a spouse of a county party chair must be filed within 7 days of February 9<sup>th</sup>. An objection that an official is married to a candidate or related to a candidate within two degrees of blood relations must be filed within 10 days of February 9<sup>th</sup>.

**NOTICE OF CANDIDATE WITHDRAWAL:**

T.W. Dotson has withdrawn his candidacy for Justice of the Peace, District 2. In accordance with A.C.A. 7-7-304, since this withdrawal comes after certification of the ballot, the candidate's name shall still appear on the 2024 Preferential Primary Ballot and the votes shall be counted, but in accordance with the law, "if the person [withdrawn candidate] receives enough votes to win the nomination, a vacancy in nomination shall exist".
