Judge Frank Weaver gave a report on the petition process for volunteer fire departments to have their annual dues placed on the property tax statements. County Clerk Tamitha Blocker reported that the fire district maps have been completed and updated with the state. Petitions and voter lists are ready and will be distributed to any fire department interested in beginning the petition process. The updated map will be put on the county's website, and copies will be distributed to each fire department. Huntsville Fire Chief Kevin Shinn addressed the court and stated that most volunteer fire departments support having their dues placed on the tax statements because each department depends heavily on dues and Act 833 money to purchase equipment and pay for maintenance which is very expensive.

Judge Weaver presented the Mountain Reserve Subdivision Plat Phase 2 for approval. Larry Garrett made a motion to approve the plat. Jack Hudgins seconded the motion. After a short discussion, a roll call vote was taken and the plat was approved with all members voting in favor of the motion, except TW Dotson, who voted against the motion.

County Judge Frank Weaver introduced Ordinance 2021-6, an appropriation ordinance. Judge Weaver explained that the appropriation was necessary to pay for a new roof on the old community building, which houses the Sheriff's administrative offices, the extension offices, and the genealogy office. T.W. Dotson made a motion to read Ordinance 2021-6. Pattie Shinn seconded the motion. All members voted in favor of the motion. County Clerk Tamitha Blocker read Ordinance 2021-6. T.W. Dotson made a motion to adopt the ordinance, and Larry Garrett seconded the motion. All members voted to adopt Ordinance No. 2021-6.

With no further business, a motion to adjourn was made by Larry Garrett and seconded by Pattie Shinn. All members voted in favor of the motion.
