The Madison County Quorum Court met on September 19, 2022, in regular session with seven members present. Justices TW Dotson and Luke Dotson were absent.

Minutes from the previous meeting were approved as written.

The Treasurer's Report was approved as presented.

The Expenditure Report was approved as presented.

County Judge Frank Weaver reported that the engineering firm hired to conduct core sample drilling on the Burkes South property will be here on September 20<sup>th</sup> to conduct the drill.

Circuit Judge Diane Warren and Circuit Judge Stacey Zimmerman addressed the court about the possible need for an additional Juvenile Officer in Madison County. Judge Warren stated that she originally intended to ask the court to consider hiring an additional Juvenile Officer; however, she and Judge Zimmerman are currently in conversation about a more cost-effective way to address the situation. No action was taken.

County Judge Frank Weaver introduced Ordinance 2022-18, an appropriation ordinance. Pattie Shinn made a motion to read Ordinance 2022-18, and Larry Garrett seconded the motion. All members voted in favor of the motion. County Clerk Tamitha Blocker read Ordinance 2022-18. After a couple of questions, Pattie Shinn made a motion to adopt Ordinance No. 2022-18, and Wendy Pettz seconded the motion. All members voted to adopt Ordinance No. 2022-18.

With no further business, a motion was made by Larry Garrett and seconded by Pattie Shinn to adjourn the meeting. The meeting was adjourned.
