The Madison County Quorum Court met in a special session on Monday, May 9, 2022, at the Madison County Courthouse, with eight members present. Matt Cleaver was absent.

County Judge Frank Weaver called the meeting to order. Justice Pattie Shinn motioned that quorum court members not be paid the per diem rate for the special session, and Larry Garrett seconded the motion. All members voted in favor.

Judge Weaver introduced Kevin Faught with Stephens, Inc from the Fayetteville office and Mike McBride from the Little Rock office. Stephens, Inc is a bonding company for large projects financed through sales tax. They presented information about how bonds work and might be used to build a new jail. There was a lengthy discussion regarding how the bonds would work, but the court did not take any action.

With no further business, a motion was made by Pattie Shinn and seconded by Larry Garrett to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor. The meeting was adjourned.
